

Getting to Exeter

The AULC Conference will take place in the Margaret Rooms in **Queen's Building** on the main University of Exeter **Streatham Campus**.

If you are coming from Exeter airport, there is an hourly bus service into town, details here <http://www.stagecoachbus.com/timetables/56379210909ver2web.pdf>

The journey takes around 20-30 minutes. If you are staying at the Jurys Inn hotel, get off at the Bus Station in Exeter.

If you wish to take a taxi, we recommend pre-booking. Gemini Taxis (Tel: 01392 666666) are generally reliable. The set fare from the airport to Queen's Building is approx.£12.

Exeter has two **railway stations** - Exeter St David's (main station) and Exeter Central. Exeter St David's Station is approximately 10 minutes walk from the Streatham Campus and taxis are available. The average journey time from London Paddington is 2 hours 30 minutes to Exeter.
